PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT Plaintiffs John Lofton, Robert Pegg, Ralph Davenport and Richard Davenport (collectively, "Plaintiffs") hereby move for final approval of the class settlement with Defendant Collecto, Inc. under Rule 23(c) and rule 23(3) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

On August 10, 2017, the Court determined, on a preliminary basis, that the parties' settlement was fair, reasonable, and adequate to the class, consistent with Rule 23(e). Dkt. No. 109. Nothing in the intervening settlement process has emerged which would undermine the Court's initial assessment. Notice has been given to the class, no class members objected and only one class member opted out.
